Homework – is an important part of a child's education and enables you to share with your child what they are learning in class. Homework for all classes will start week commencing September 12th. Please continue to support your child to complete any tasks in the given time; we do try to accommodate all circumstances by giving you the choice to complete the work with your child over the weekend or during the week. Thank you for your support with this. Children in Foundation Phase will receive their homework on a **Thursday**. Homework at KS2 will be given on a **Monday**.

Reading – is a vital part of a child's development regardless of age or ability and they should be encouraged to read a little every night. We value the comments you also record in your child's 'Reading Record' and it is a constant liaison between home and school when we don't always see you to talk to face to face. Just your initials are sufficient just so that we know that you have read the comments in your child's 'Reading Record' from school also. Please may we remind you that Years 1 to 6 take home their reading book every night and it should be returned to school every day as the children could possibly need them during the school day, or may need to change the book. Reception children will be given a sounds book to practise sounds at home and will be given a reading book to take home once they know all their Jolly Phonics sounds.

Your support throughout the year is much appreciated.

Punctuality – 8.55am and 3.15pm – The bell is rung at 8.55am and 3.15pm by a Year 6 monitor to alert the start and end of the school day. The children have settled in really well and therefore parents are kindly asked to leave their child on the yard to play and socialise with their friends after they have brought them onto the yard in the mornings. Thank you for your cooperation with this.
