Cool Kidz Club is an after school club and holiday club, run within Brynford School. It is run by a committee of parents who employ the staff.

The manager / senior play worker are trained to QCF level 5 & NVQ level 3 in childcare. Play workers have training from NVQ level 2 upwards. All staff have DBS checks, food hygiene and first aid trained. Most of the staff currently work within the school during the day and know the children well.

The club aims to provide a safe and secure environment and an atmosphere similar to home for children whilst they are at the club.

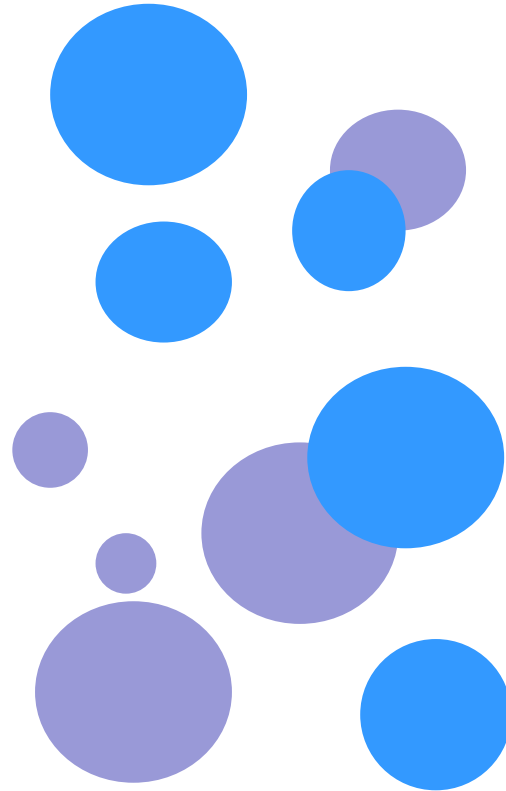

This leaflet outlines the services and values that children, parents/carers and the community can expect from Cool kidz Club (Brynford). We hope that you find it useful. If you have any questions please contact us.

Our club aims to:

- Provide a happy, safe, warm and stimulating environment for all children to play, learn and develop freely.
- Help children to develop responsibility for themselves and their actions and to become competent, confident, independent and co-operative individuals.
- Encourage children to have a positive attitude and respect for both themselves and other people.
- Promote a positive relationship with parents/carers and work in partnership with them to provide high quality play and care for their children.
- Offer inclusive services to all children who attend.
- Undergo regular monitoring and evaluation of our services to ensure that the Club continues to meet the needs of children and parents/carers.
- Have a team of staff that is experienced, trained and properly supported, kind and friendly.

Our Clubs is for:

- Children from age 3 to 11 years.
- Both sexes.
- The club is registered for 24 children.
- The Children attend Brynford School or local area schools and will be admitted as per the admissions policy.
- There will be at least two staff working in the club, with a ration of 1 staff : 8 children, at least one will be level 3 or above qualified with first aid and food hygiene training.
- The club intends to provide a very flexible care facility which will be driven by the children's needs and a flexible structure.
- We will make every effort to accommodate children with special needs.

Our Club Facilities are:

- The club will be run from within Brynford School using mainly the hall but with the option of using any of the classrooms.
- We will also have access to the outside areas including the field, playground and the all weather court.
- The club will be open from 3:15pm until 6:00pm Monday to Friday in term time. Holiday Club runs 8am-6pm daily (the club will follow Brynford Schools Holiday rota including training days).
- The children attending after school club will be collected by the Staff and signed in until picked up by a parent/guardian.
- Drinks will be available at all times, breakfast and a light nutritional snack will be provided, daily during the holiday club. Children are to bring a pack lunch, as we do not provide a main meal.
- **Billing** - Bills are done on a monthly bases and a 5 days notice to cancel any pre-booked sessions is expected.

Club Activities:

- A programme of activities that is interesting, educational, stimulating and fun.
- Activities that promote each child's social, physical, moral and intellectual development including craft activities, games, quiet corner, access to the computers and outside play area.
- Access to a variety of facilities and equipment under safe and supervised conditions.
- Services that meet the conditions of the Children's Act 1989, and all other relevant childcare legislation, wherever they apply.
- An environment where no child is bullied or suffers discrimination in any form.
- The children can choose to participate in the arranged activities or initiate their own.
- The children will be offered outside play, nature walks and local area park under constant supervision, weather permitting.
