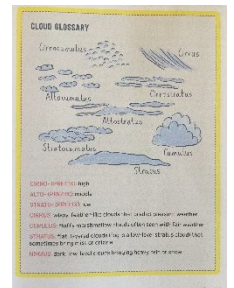
Science and Technology
