Florence Nightingale was born on 12th May 1820 in Florence, Italy. After training to be a nurse in Germany, Florence became famous while serving as a nurse during the Crimean War by helping thousands of injured soldiers.

After moving to England,
Florence laid the foundations
of professional nursing with
the establishment of her
nursing school at St Thomas'
Hospital in London. It was the
first nursing school in the
world, and is now part of
King's College London.

In recognition of her pioneering work in nursing, the Nightingale Pledge is taken by all new nurses and International Nurses Day is celebrated on her birthday.

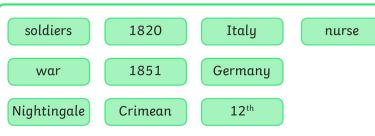
